

Erasmus+ mobility program

Europe needs inclusive societies that allow their citizens to play an active role in democratic life. Education and youth work are key to promoting common European values of social inclusion, strengthening intercultural understanding and a sense of belonging to a community, as well as preventing violent extremism. The Erasmus+ Program in Higher Education contributes dynamically to this promotion by enhancing, through mobility, the possibilities of cooperation with the Program Countries and Partner Countries.

Mobilities

Mobility through the Erasmus+ program is addressed to students and University staff, teaching and administrative, from/to collaborating institutions of countries within the EU, (Classic Mobility) and outside the EU. (International Credit Mobility).

Erasmus + for Students

Erasmus+ enables undergraduate, postgraduate or doctoral students to carry out a small part of their **studies** abroad. Attendance at the University Abroad is recognized by assigning equivalent courses (and ECTS credits).

Internships at employers (companies **or** organizations) in program countries are another opportunity given to students or recent graduates to gain experience and broaden their career prospects.

Erasmus+ for staff

The teaching and administrative staff have the possibility to travel to Universities in Program countries and in Partner Countries. Teaching staff are given the opportunity to teach to audiences at the host university or to be trained by members of the host university community. The administrative staff is given the opportunity to exchange know-how and administrative culture with other institutions operating in a different institutional environment.
