# **Lodz University, Poland**

#### THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship is **800 EUR per month** (individual support). The final amount of the scholarship will be calculated on the confirmation of stay which is issued based on the student's physical stay at the University of Lodz.

Additionally, the grantee will receive a lump sum of **travel cost** calculated at the shortest route according to the distance calculator available at the following

### **STUDENTS WITH FEWER OPPORTUNITIES**

## Allocation rules for students with fewer opportunities:

To facilitate access to mobility for students as much as possible, higher education institutions must ensure equal and equitable access and opportunities to current and prospective participants from all backgrounds. This means including participants with fewer opportunities, such as:

- participants with certified physical and health problems;
- economic disadvantage evidenced by maintenance scholarship/financial aid issued by the home university to the student.

For the category of students with fewer opportunities, the **additional grant** in the amount of **250 EUR per month** may be awarded, in addition to the ordinary grant.

Please note: The University of Lodz cannot guarantee a scholarship for students with fewer opportunities to all applying participants. In order to be eligible for funding, the disadvantaged status must be certified by the home university. All documents certified the student status need to be translated into English. The priority is given to students with fewer opportunities.

#### Travel – standard travel

Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission <a href="https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator">https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator</a>. The applicant must indicate the distance of a one-way travel to calculate the amount of the EU grant that will support the round trip.

Additionally, visa cost is reimbursed up to 100 EUR.

The grantee must buy his/her own ticket, and the money will be reimbursed up to the set by the programm
