



## Exchange semester at Tilburg University – The Netherlands

Tilburg University is a public research university specialising in the social and behavioural sciences, economics, law, business sciences, theology and humanities, located in Tilburg in the southern part of the Netherlands. Tilburg University has a student population of about 17,400 students, about 18 percent of whom are international students. This percentage has steadily increased over the past years. Tilburg University offers both Dutch-and English-taught programmes.

As an exchange student, you do not have to pay a tuition fee at Tilburg University. Instead, you will continue to pay your regular fees to your home institution.

### Fields of Study

At Tilburg University, you can choose from a wide selection of over 300 English-taught courses per semester.

Tilburg University offers a broad variety of undergraduate and graduate level courses to exchange students in the following disciplines:

- Economics and Management
- Law
- Humanities
- Social and Behavioral Sciences
- Catholic Theology

### Scholarship opportunity

Students from the University of Pretoria have the opportunity to study at Tilburg University in The Netherlands in a semester exchange programme with a scholarship.

For the University of Pretoria students there is a scholarship of € 6000,- available for 1 student per academic year, for a duration of 1 semester.

If you have been selected by the University of Pretoria to study at Tilburg University with this Scholarship, then you will receive this scholarship in installments, starting as soon as you have arrived at Tilburg University in The Netherlands and are meeting the scholarship conditions\*.
