Tip Make sure your device is fully charged before you start your exam. If possible, keep your device plugged in to charge while completing the exam.

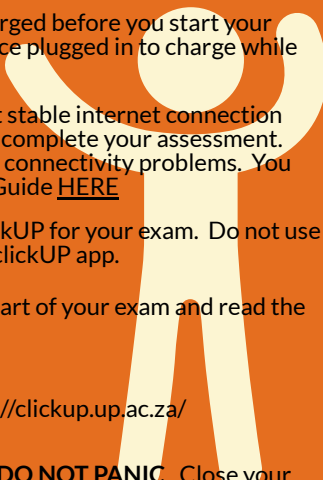

Tip Use Google Chrome to access clickUP for your exam. Do not use another Internet Browser or the clickUP app.

Tip Log in a few minutes before the start of your exam and read the exam instructions carefully.
