- User research and design

- UX in public and/or school libraries
- UX in academic libraries

Abstracts should be 250 - 300 words, including names of proposed speakers/facilitators and submitted through our online submission system by 30 June 2023. All submissions will be reviewed by our expert panel and acceptance notifications will be sent out by 30 July 2023.

We look forward to your submissions and your participation in the International Symposium on User Experience in September, which promises to be an enriching and engaging event.

- Title of the paper or workshop proposal
- Names, affiliations, and email addresses of all presenters
- A clear and concise abstract of the presentation or workshop proposal
- The relevance of the presentation or workshop proposal to the theme of the symposium
- A brief overview of the activities, outcomes, or learning objectives (for workshops)
- Closing date for abstract submissions is 30 June 2023
