

1	Report to UP Crisis Line 0800 006 428
2	Capture personal details Engage UP Investigator
3	Collect information – Explain process Arrange transport to TRCC or Hospivission Open SAPS docket (If requested) Report to UP Transformation office
4	HIV testing and support excluding PEP Forensic collection (may be limited) Counselling Pregnancy and Health advice
5	Commence criminal investigation Explain judicial procedure
6	Prima Facie assessment
	Commence disciplinary investigation Explain UP disciplinary procedure
