#### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

**1) What is the SRC Elections ClickUP Module?**

The **SRC Elections ClickUP Module** is the official elections platform that will be used to communicate to students throughout the SRC elections process. It will also be used to conduct key election processes through the zero-rated environment to ensure accessibility by all UP students.

**2) What are the minimum requirements to be nominated as a candidate for the SRC in the SRC Election?**

**3) Where can I access a Nomination Form?**

You can find a digital nomination form on the **SRC Elections ClickUP** module via the **Candidate Nomination Form Tab**.

**4) Where and how do I submit a Nomination Form?**

All nomination forms are submitted digitally via the **Candidate Nomination Form tab** on the **SRC Elections ClickUP Module**.

**5) If I decide to run as a candidate in the SRC elections, do I need a nominator? or could I nominate myself?**

According to the Constitution of Student Governance, any registered student can be a nominator - that includes yourself!

**6) How do I acquire signatures to support my nomination to run for the SRC?**

- After your digital nomination form has been processed and approved by the IEC, your digital nomination **Secondment Form** will be loaded on the **SRC Elections ClickUP Module** within the **Nomination Signatures Tab**.
- You can direct students to digitally sign your **Secondment Form** via the **Nomination Signatures Tab** to support your nomination.

**7) How many signatures do I need to gather to second my nomination?**

To be eligible to be elected to the SRC you must have the support of 200 registered students if you are running for the **Presidential Portfolio**, or **100** registered students if you are running for other portfolios.

**8) How do I sign a nominee's Secondment Form to support a candidate virtually?**

You can second a nomination by accessing the nominee's **Secondment Form** via the **SRC Elections ClickUP module** under the **Nomination Signatures tab** and follow the instructions accordingly.
