1. Attend one of our Vice-Chancellor and Principal's Welcome Sessions and drop your entry form into the Bursary Draw Box. *Bursary winners will be drawn by Prof Tawana Kupe, Vice-Chancellor and Principal of the University of Pretoria.*
2. Attend your preferred faculty's Dean Information Session and drop your completed entry form into the Bursary Draw Box. *Bursary winners will be drawn by the Dean/Deputy Dean of the Faculty.*

This payment will automatically enter you into the #ChooseUP Bursary Draw. *Bursary winners will be determined by randomised draw of students who paid their initial fee.*

#ChooseUP Bursary Draw rules

- Bursaries are valid for students who will be registering at UP as first-year students for the first time in 2020 and already have a student number.
- Validity of the bursary does not extend beyond 2020, hence it cannot be held over for studies that commence in 2021 or later.
- Entrants must be present at the draw on 17 August 2019. If a winner is not present, the person will forfeit the prize and another draw will take place.
- Entries for one session are not valid for other sessions.
- Only one entry per prospective student (per session) is allowed.
- Bursaries are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
- Winners of bursaries are subject to the normal admission requirements, selection procedures and general bursary rules and conditions.
- The bursary amount cannot be used for payment of registration fees (initial fees).
