# JuniorTukkie initiatives deliver pleasing graduation results




#### Make today matter


# JuniorTukkie members – 2010-2022 JTs (2011-2023 first-years)


# JuniorTukkie Grade 12 Preparation Conference –2009-2022 (2010-2023 first-years)

Learners in Grade 12 who have been conditionally admitted/admitted to study at UP, are invited to this annual JuniorTukkie Grade 12 Preparation Conference.




## JT Grade 11 Empowerment Week Attendees – 2007-2021 JTs (2009-2023 first-years)
