BACKGROUND

The PRF works to support research aimed at furthering the development of Medical Virology in South Africa. There are two calls per year (faculty closing date: 15 February and 1 September).

Applications are invited for funding under the following six categories:

- Post-Doctoral Fellowship
- Bursary
- James Gear Fellowship
- Travel Grant
- Research Grant
- Major Impact Project (MIP)

At present and for the time being, due to the large funding requirements for Research Grants and Bursaries, NO applications for Post-Doctoral Fellowships and Travel Grants will be considered and therefore should **NOT** be submitted for 2021.

Bursary

Bursaries are ordinarily awarded only to South African citizens or persons with permanent residency permits for South Africa. A limited number of bursaries may be awarded to other non-South African applicants. BSc (Hons) and Masters Applicants must have minimum pass of 60% to be considered.

Maximum duration of support will be 2 years for Masters and 3 years for PhD bursaries.

Research Grant

Research grants are awarded to establish researchers who have a track record of independent innovative research supported by a significant publication record. Awarded to applicants in possession of PhD or equivalent degree / Or in exceptional cases the Principal Investigator may have a master's degree and at least 3 or more years of research experience and publications.

Major Impact Project (MIP)

The funding ceiling is R 500 000 per annum for 3 years.

Please note that if funding is awarded for contract research (excluding scholarships), a 15% UP recovery is applicable and should be budgeted for by the applicant.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Bursary:

Applicants working full-time positions (receiving a salary) may NOT apply

Research grant: (No 2nd Round, thus February submissions only)

- Only applicants with a PhD/equivalent degree may apply, in extraordinary cases an applicant with a master's degree and 3 or more years experience may apply.
- The research proposal must have ethics approval.
