#### **BACKGROUND**

The <u>Swiss Government Excellence Scholarships</u> are aimed at young researchers from abroad who have completed a master's degree or PhD. For South African citizens, three different types of fully funded scholarships are offered starting in September 2022 in all academic fields.

## Fundings are offered for the following three streams:

- 1. PhD Scholarships
- 2. Postdoctoral Scholarships
- 3. Research Scholarships (Academics & Medical Doctors)

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Citizens of South African, Botswana, Lesotho, the Kingdom of Eswatini, Namibia and Mauritius (with global outreach);
- Master's degree or equivalent university degree achieved before 31 July 2022 (degree certificate) recognized by the Swiss university. As a proof, the degree has to be submitted to the Federal Commission for Scholarships before the start of the scholarship;
- Applicants who have been in Switzerland since more than one year at the beginning of the scholarship in September are not eligible. Reference document if applicable: residence permit to be added to the application documents;
- Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Excellence Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship.

## **PhD Scholarships**

- The scholarship is valid for 12 months and renewable for a maximum of 3 years;
- Applicants should have a Master's degree or equivalent University degree recognized by a Swiss University;
- The applicant must not be older than 35 years at the time of application (born after 31 December 1986).

#### **Postdoctoral Scholarships**

- The scholarship is valid for 12 months and renewable for a maximum of 6 months;
- The applicants should have a PhD degree;
- There cannot be a gap of more than 5 years between the award of the PhD and the application deadline.

# **Research Scholarships**

- The Scholarship is intended for highly qualified postdoctoral researchers from all academic fields as well as young Medical Doctors;
- The scholarship is valid for **12 months maximum and non-renewable**;
- The applicant should have a Master's degree or equivalent;
- The applicant must not be older than 35 years at the time of application (born after 31 December 1986).

### **IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS:**

The Federal Commission for Scholarships for Foreign Students assesses scholarship applications according to three criteria:

- a) Candidate profile;
- b) Quality of the research project or artistic work;
- c) Synergies and potential for future research cooperation

## What the fellowship offers

- Stipend: Postdoctoral research: CHF 3500/month;
- Stipend: PhD and Research scholarship: CHF 1920/month;
- Mandatory Swiss health insurance;
- One-time lump sum of CHF 300.-with the first grant payment to help for payment of the housing deposit;
- Flight allowance (lump sum) for a ticket back to their country of origin (provided at the end of the scholarship);
- One-year half-fare public transportation card.
