BACKGROUND

The Laura Bassi Scholarship was established by Editing Press in 2018 with the **aim of providing editorial assistance to postgraduates and junior academics whose research focuses on neglected topics of study**, broadly construed, within their disciplines. The scholarships are open to every discipline and are awarded twice a year: December and April. The value of the scholarships are remitted through editorial assistance as follows:

Master's candidates: \$750

Doctoral candidates: \$2,500

Junior academics: \$500

These figures reflect the upper bracket of costs of **editorial assistance for master's theses, doctoral dissertations, and academic journal articles**, respectively.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- All **currently enrolled masters and doctoral candidates** are eligible to apply
- Academics in the **first five years** of their employment
- There are no institutional, departmental, or national restrictions

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION

- To help defray the Scholarship's administrative costs, **applicants are subject to a voluntary USD 10.00 fee**.
- All applicants who are unable to pay the application fee are welcome to take advantage of the **fee waiver option** on the [application portal](#).
- If you wish to pay the application fee in a non-USD currency, please consult the [FAQ](#).
- In order to avoid delays, applicants are encouraged to read the FAQ carefully before writing to us with their questions.
- Please **do not** submit your application material by email, as this would breach the impartiality rules and potentially invalidate your application.
- If you wish to update your application material, please upload your documents afresh using the same email address as your initial submission. Your dossier will then update automatically.

- **Please also note that your application documents need to be uploaded together rather than separately.**
