| 28 March 2022 | Queen Elizabeth Commonwealth Scholarship - cycle 2 2022-23 | Open to applicants from any Commonwealth country, the scholarships provide a unique opportunity to study for a two-year Master's degree at an ACU member university in a low or middle income country. |
| 4 April 2022 | ACU Fellowships | Fellowships for academic and professional staff at ACU member universities to promote the exchange of knowledge, skills, and ideas between members. |
| 2 May 2022 | Routledge Commonwealth Studentships | The PhD studentships provide funding for research projects on Commonwealth-related themes. |

A candidate must read the respective award of interest's guideline from the $\underline{\text{website}}$ for the different calls.

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS:

The first call (Gender Grants) will on the week of the 23rd August 2021.

<u>ACU Gender Grants</u> are awarded annually to member universities to support initiatives that will boost gender equity and equality on campus. The grants can be used for a <u>diverse range of projects</u>, workshops, and events in areas such as:

- Supporting women in leadership.
- Raising awareness of sexual harassment and developing anti-sexual harassment initiatives.
- Supporting women in science and research.
- Creating effective institutional policies.
- Mainstreaming gender equity into the curriculum.

Grants of up to GBP 1000 are available for staff at ACU member universities to help meet the costs of organising projects that promote gender equity and equality.

Grantees will be required to submit a short interim report halfway through their project and a comprehensive final report within one month after completing their project.

Further information will be circulated for the different calls when they open.

HOW TO APPLY

A candidate will need to supply an outline of the project and an action plan, including details of what it involves and how it will address gender equity and equality at your university. The project action plan is requested for a minimum of 6 months and a maximum of 12 months. Further application details will be available when the calls open.
