



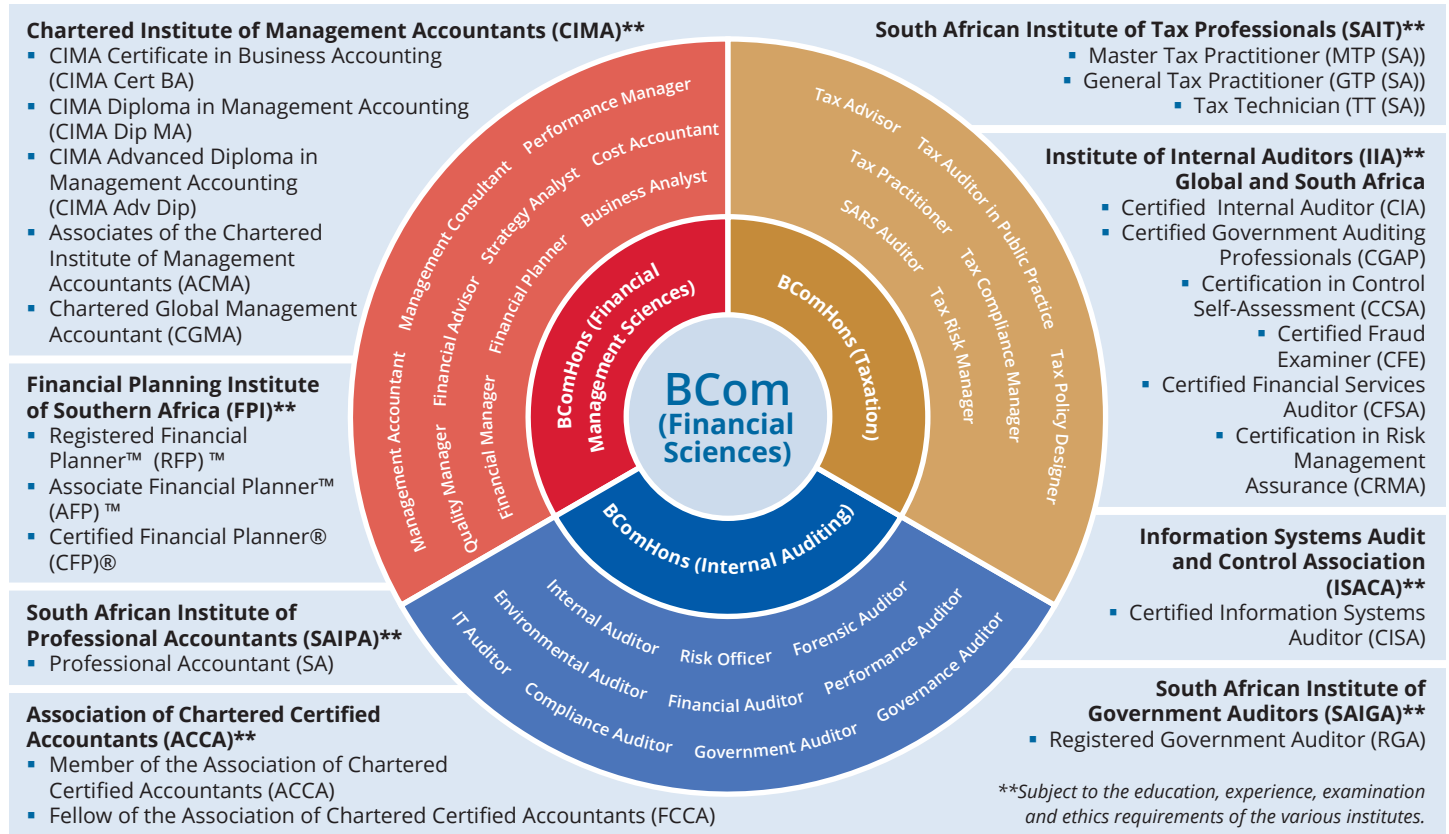
BCom (Financial Sciences)
