Dear EMS Students,

The Health Regulations allow for the use of indoor venues to 50% of their capacity if the attendees of gatherings are vaccinated or have a negative PCR test. The 50% of capacity is limited to a maximum of 1000 persons in cases where there is no vaccine rule or requirement for a negative PCR test in force. This means that at UP, venues can be used to 50% of their capacity up to a **maximum of 1000 persons**, whichever is the lesser, as UP has no vaccine rule in force.

With this change in regulations for gatherings and the fact that social distancing in venues is no longer a requirement, it is now possible for a greater number of students to attend classes in person on campus.

Therefore, from the second semester, which starts on 25 July 2022, all classes in the EMS Faculty will revert back to the traditional mode of instruction, namely **face-to-face contact classes on campus**. In some instances, especially with the larger groups, contact classes will be on a rotational basis.
