Requirements to qualify for a special exam for the BCom Extended Programme

A student requiring no more than 2 semester modules (excluding AIM 133 and AIM 143) to successfully complete their first year at the Mamelodi Campus, may apply to write a special exam subject to the following conditions:

If a student passed all the other modules with the exception of the following scenarios:

- Failed 1 module (excluding AIM); (wrote the exam or were not admitted to the exam)
or
- Failed 2 modules (excluding AIM) but were admitted to the exam in both; or
- Failed 2 modules (excluding AIM) – wrote the exam in 1 and was not admitted to the exam in the other; or
- Failed 2 modules (excluding AIM) with no exam entry in both but obtained at least a 25% semester mark;

they will be allowed to write the special exam scheduled for Jan 2024.

The exams will be scheduled from 15 to 20 January 2024.
