## **ACADEMIC EXCLUSIONS**

## **BCOM 4 YEAR PROGRAMME**

### **END OF 2024**

This has been a transitional year and the following requirements must be adhered to:

- More than two core modules failed exclude.
- After special exams if any of the two core modules are failed exclude

#### **Appeals**

- Appeals close on 20 January excluded students must be reminded about the appeal process in time to still appeal.
- NO LATE applications for appeals will be considered.

### Credits based on modules passed at Mamelodi during 2024

- Core modules passed at Mamelodi during 2024 will still be credited for Hatfield modules in the beginning of 2025 provided BOTH semesters for the applicable module were passed.
- From 2025, this will however not be allowed any more as the first year is a bridging year and the modules form part of the approved curriculum.

# **FROM 2025**

- In order to register for the next year of study a student must pass at least 66% of the official credits listed for a year level of study for a four-year programme.
- **NB**: Taking cognisance of the required 66%, it is expected of students who have registered for the first year of the BCom Four year programme to pass, as a minimum, five modules of the following prescribed discipline specific modules:
  - Financial Accounting (FRK 133 and FRK 143)
  - Business Management (OBS 133 and OBS 143)
  - Statistics (STK 133 and STK 143)
  - Mathematics (BAM 133)
- Students who do not pass all modules during the first semester of the first year will be excluded if they fail any one of the above core modules.
- Bridging core modules (i.e. modules passed in the first year of registration) will not be credited as the modules form part of the approved curriculum and students need to pass all the modules listed in the official yearbook.

#### **Transfers**

- Transfers to another BCom degree are not permitted after the first year of registration in the Four-year Programme.
- Students may only apply for a transfer at the conclusion of their second year, provided they
  meet the requirements outlined in the EMS Transfer Guide.
