## WHAT COMES NEXT?



Check the UP Student Portal at [www1.up.ac.za](http://www1.up.ac.za) and accept the programme offer.



If you no longer want to study the programme or if you are not coming to the University of Pretoria, please reject the offer on the UP Student Portal. Do this as soon as possible to provide space for other students who want to study at UP.



Read the letters on your UP Student Portal under 'Communication'.



Pay your initial fee of **R5 000**. If you have been placed in a residence, pay a further **R5 700** as soon as possible (no later than the first week of December). Banking details are available at: [www.up.ac.za/fees-and-funding](http://www.up.ac.za/fees-and-funding).



Complete your student contract on the UP Student Portal\*. Print the contract, sign it and hand it in at the Student Service Centre or send it to us by courier. Avoid the long queues and submit the contract before **10 December 2019**.



Apply for NSFAS funding ([nsfas.org.za](http://nsfas.org.za)) or other bursaries ([www.up.ac.za/fees-and-funding](http://www.up.ac.za/fees-and-funding)) before the end of **November 2019**.



To stay informed of what is happening, download the Junior Tukkies app on Android or iOS cellphones or tablets. Go to [www.up.ac.za/juniortukkies](http://www.up.ac.za/juniortukkies) and click on JT APP. Keep checking the UP website ([www.up.ac.za](http://www.up.ac.za)) for the latest information.



## WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN JANUARY?

1. You will receive an SMS in the **second week of January 2020** prompting you to check your updated application status on the UP Student Portal.
2. From **13 January 2020**, your final admission status, based on your NSC/IEB results, will be available on the UP Student Portal.
3. Register online from **13 to 31 January 2020** if:
  - your student contract has been completed and delivered to UP;
  - your initial payment of **R5 000** (and your additional fee of **R5 700** if you have been accepted in a residence) have been paid; and
  - you still meet all the minimum programme admission requirements with your final NSC/IEB results.
4. Should you need any assistance with the above, come to the **Hillcrest Campus from 13 January 2020**.
5. Collect your student card in person at the Hillcrest Campus\* **on or before 25 January 2020**. You will need your student card to access the Hatfield Campus to attend Orientation Week.
6. Attend Welcome Day for new first-year students and parents on **Saturday, 25 January 2020**.
7. **Attend Orientation Week from 27 to 31 January 2020**. You will interact with staff and get information on the correct module choice, credits and prerequisites.

If you need any information, come and see us at the Hillcrest Campus\* from **13 January and bring your ID with you**.
