WHAT COMES NEXT?



Check the student portal at www1.up.ac.za and accept the programme offer.

If you no longer want to study the programme or if you are not coming to the University of Pretoria, in 2021, then please reject the offer on your student portal.

Do this as soon as possible to provide an opportunity for another student.



Read the letters on your UP Student Portal under '**Communication**'.



Pay your initial fee of **R5 000**. If you have been placed in a residence, pay a further **R5 700** as soon as possible.

Complete your student contract on the UP student portal. Print the contract, sign it and mail or courier it to: Private Bag X20 Hatfield 0028

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN February/March?



Complete the online pre-orientation from **15 February 2021**. Visit www.up.ac.za/orientation for more information and updates



Check your final (new) admission status from **1 March 2021**, on the UP student portal. This new status will be based on your final school leaving certificate: NSC, IEB, etc.



Then register online from **1 to 9 March 2021** if:

- Your student contract has been completed and delivered to UP and is valid;
- Your initial payment of **R5 000** (and additional fee of **R5 700** if you have been admitted to a residence) has been paid;
- You still meet the minimum programme admission requirements with your final IEB/NSC results.

You will need a UP access card to enter the campus and attend Orientation. Once you have registered, you will get a confirmation of registration and then have to make a booking to collect your student card.

Attend the first-year orientation from **9 – 12 March 2021**.

You will interact with staff and get information on the correct module choice, credits and prerequisites.



Check the UP web regularly for the latest information.



Note that UP follows a blended teaching and learning approach, which includes both online learning and in-person classes. It is therefore important for students to have access to an internet-enabled device, preferably a laptop. The minimum recommended specifications are an i3 processor with 8GB of Ram and 500GB of storage. Some faculties require higher specifications and specific software.
