

What comes next?

Check the student portal at

www1.up.ac.za and accept the programme offer.

If you no longer want to study the programme or if you are not coming to the University of Pretoria, in 2024, then please reject the offer on your student portal. Do this as soon as possible to provide an opportunity for another student.

Read the letters on your UP student portal under "Communication".

Pay your initial fee of R10 000.
If you have been placed in a UP official residence, pay a further R5 700 as soon as possible.

Complete your student contract on the **UP student portal. Print** the contract, **sign it** and **mail** or **courier** it to:

What will happen in January/February?



Check your final (new) admission status from 23 January 2024 on the UP student portal. This status will be based on your final school leaving certificate: NSC, IEB, etc.

Then register online from 25 January 2024 if:

- Your student contract has been completed, delivered to UP and is valid;
- Your initial payment of R10 000 (and additional fee of R5 700 only if you have been admitted to an official UP residence) has been paid;
- You still meet the minimum programme admission requirements with your final IEB/NSC results.

- Students need to register before being issued a student card.

 Student cards can only be issued 24 hours after registering at the Hillcrest campus until **16 February 2024.**

- Attend the first-year **orientation from 12 16 February 2024**. You will interact with staff and get information on the correct module choice, credits and prerequisites.
