

BEd Hons 2024 Information and Packages

The BEd Hons at UP is designed as a two-year, part-time program. A blended learning approach is followed, involving class attendance on alternating Friday afternoons, with online assignments scheduled for weeks in between contact sessions. There are seven different BEd Hons packages to choose from. Each package consists of eight modules scheduled as two modules per semester.

Students who are not employed are allowed to register for full-time studies to complete the program in one year. Consequently, full time students attend class every Friday while also having to complete their online activities. These students should register for Year 1 as well as for Year 2 modules, amounting to four modules per semester. Full time study is challenging and not recommended for students who have other obligations.

An orientation session for new students will be offered on Monday, 19 February 2024, online, from 15h00-17h00. During this session you will receive training in the use of the online learning system (ClickUP) as well as the library system. Be sure that you register online for the BEd Hons course before or on 19 February 2024 to enable you to login to the ClickUP system for training on 19 February. Students who completed their undergraduate studies at UP are not required to attend the full session if they are acquainted with ClickUp and the UP library. They may just need to familiarise them with the general organisation of the modules.

Details of the seven packages are outlined below on pages 2-4, showing module names and codes. The two modules to be taken in each semester are indicated for each of the seven packages. Students should register for modules according to their year of study.

According to the language policy of the University of Pretoria, modules for the BEd Honors are offered only in English as from 2018.
