It is compulsory to attend the **Orientation programme** that will take place on **Groenkloof Campus**, c/o George Storrer- and Leydstreets, Groenkloof, University of Pretoria, from **28 January 2019** — **1 February 2019**. During this week you will receive all the information about the programme and subjects that you are registered for, and meet all the staff that will be involved with your studies for the next four years.

Students who have been allocated a space in residence may move in as from Friday 25 January 2019. Residence information have been communicated with them already.

Lectures commence on Monday 4 February 2019. The BEd programmes, subjects and the lecture time table will be discussed with you during the course of the Orientation week. You are advised, to register online as from 9 January 2019.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration: Online registration for 1st year students opens on 9 January 2019. All undergraduate students must register before 28 January 2019. If you are experiencing problems with the online registration process, you can phone, 012 420 5347, or send an email to: registration@up.ac.za, or register before 28 January 2019 on the Hillcrest (Sports) Campus of the University of Pretoria, South Street, Hatfield, Pretoria (GPS coordinates: S25° 45′ 10″ E28º 14′ 46″). Assisted online registration will be available at the Hillcrest Campus from 10 January 2019 until 26 January 2019. Gates will be open 08:00 to 15:30.

Contracts: All first year students have to upload signed contracts on the Student Portal. If not done yet, the original signed document can be submitted at the Hillcrest Campus (Sports Campus), before registration can take place.

Fees payable prior to registration:

Registration fee:

You will not be able to register online unless your registration fee of R5 000 has been paid. Please note that the full registration fee needs to be paid and that no arrangements can be made to pay the registration fee in instalments. If you qualify for NSFAS or any bursary that will exempt you from the registration fee, please visit the university web page: www.up.ac.za/fees-and-funding.

Bursary holders:

Bursary holders must submit proof of the bursary award at the Hillcrest Campus at LC De Villiers, or send via email to ssc@up.ac.za in order to clear the financial block on the student's record. Please note that a student remains responsible for the student account if the bursary sponsor does not pay the account.

Proof of registration:

You are only regarded as a registered student once your proof of registration appears on the portal. The payment of a deposit, an initial payment or tuition fee does not constitute registration.

International students:

International students must submit copies of their passports, study visas and medical aid together with the international form at the Hillcrest Campus at LC De Villiers, before they will be allowed to register.

Student card:

After registration, a student must obtain a student card at the Hillcrest Campus at LC De Villiers, as soon as they are registered. Proof of registration is required.

You must attend all sessions scheduled from 28 January 2019 – 1 February 2019 in the Orientation programme.

Final 2019 NSC Grade 12 Results:

Conditionally admitted students should note that the University of Pretoria will be processing the final 2018 Grade 12 results from 5 to 6 January 2019. Please access your portal (MyTuks Login), from 7 January 2019 to confirm your final admission status.

If you cannot register online you can come to the Hillcrest Campus, at LC de Villiers Sport Facilities, South Street, Hatfield, Pretoria, for assistance with registration from 10 January 2019.

Step 1: Login to the University portal, click on the UP Student Centre link and check whether you have any holds on your record. The holds refer to your contract, ID document, or Gr 12 results outstanding, that need to be submitted before you will be allowed to register.
