Language requirements

Take note: All Foundation Phase students must specialise in home language teaching in one of the official languages, together with English First Additional Language.

For example:

- If you study English as Home Language, you must also study an African language at basic conversational (beginners) level
- If you select to study an African language at Home Language level, you must study English as First Additional Language level
- Afrikaans and English languages are presented in the Literacy Practices core modules

Only choose a language as home language if you speak it or had that language as a Grade 12 subject. Otherwise, you should take the language at beginner level.
