

South African Reserve Bank and the University of Pretoria MPhil and PhD Fellowships in Macroeconomics

The Department of Economics at the University of Pretoria is proud to announce postgraduate fellowship opportunities for full-time Masters and PhD students interested primarily in Macroeconomics, Monetary Economics and International Finance.

This fellowship program specifically targets students from previously disadvantaged backgrounds (and it is only available for South Africans). Currently, there is space for up to five students, who will be chosen selectively.

In order to be considered, students need to apply for the postgraduate program for which they would like to be considered, MPhil Economics or PhD Economics. Once you have applied, please, inform the department, through Sindi, that you have applied for the program and that you would like to be considered for the fellowship. Please, also include a CV (that lists potential references).

For the MPhil, funding is for a maximum of two years, and currently includes tuition and registration fees, as well as a research and travel allowance. For the PhD, funding is for three years, and also includes tuition, registration fees, and a research and travel allowance.

MPhil and PhD applications are due by the end of September 2017.
