



SHORT CV: PROFESSOR MASHUDU TSHIFULARO

Professor Mashudu Tshifularo, born in early 1960's in the Limpopo Province of South Africa, is Head of the Department of ENT and Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Pretoria and Steve Biko Academic Hospital. He hails from a family of scholars and was called upon to serve as the youngest and only black Professor of ENT in South Africa in the year 2000.

Professor Tshifularo has wide-ranging interests in the fields of Otology, Rhinology and Paediatric ENT. He is an innovator with several patents for his own designs of middle ear implants that he started working on while still writing his PhD thesis.

He has published in peer-reviewed journals and travelled extensively lecturing about, amongst others, HIV manifestations in the field of Otorhinolaryngology, rhinology, otology and cochlear implants.

Professor Tshifularo has a passion for teaching students and aspiring ENT surgeons. He loves the outdoors where he's found watching birds and other animals of the African bush.
