### ACCEPT OFFER

Register online Check your account on the student portal at [www1.up.ac.za](http://www1.up.ac.za) and accept the programme offer. If you no longer want to study the programme or you are no longer coming to the University of Pretoria in 2021, then please reject the offer on your student portal account.

Do this as soon as possible to make the opportunity available to another student.

### CHECK COMMUNICATION

Read the letters on your UP student portal account under "Communication".

### PAY FEES

Pay your initial fee of **R 5 000**. If you have been placed in a UP official residence, pay a further **R 5 700** as soon as possible.

### LOOK OUT FOR PRE-ORIENTATION COMMUNICATION

### CHECK ADMISSION STATUS

Check your final (new) admission status from **25 January 2022** on the UP student portal. This status will be based on your final school leaving certificate: NSC, IEB, etc.

### REGISTER ONLINE

Then register online from **25 January 2022** if:

- Your student contract has been completed and delivered to UP and is valid;
- Your initial payment of **R5 000** (and additional fee of **R5 700** if you have been admitted to an official residence) has been paid;
- You still meet the minimum programme admission requirements with your final IEB/NSC results.

### ACCESS/ STUDENT CARD
