

# Notes on completing HIV&AIDS Section

Child PIP v4.0

When completing the HIV&AIDS section, use the HIV&AIDS status at the time of admission (NOT at the time of the audit) as it is the status while alive that determines clinical decision making, and quality of care

# Mother: HIV status

### Not HIV infected

Mother tested antibody negative

#### **HIV infected: on ART**

Mother on ART, including if ART interrupted currently and regardless of whether viral suppression or not

#### HIV infected: NOT on ART

Mother not on ART

#### Unknown

Insufficient information available to make one of the above choices

# Perinatal ARV - this applies to both mother and child!

#### **Guideline followed**

- Guideline refers to the national guideline in use at the relevant time

#### **Guideline NOT followed**

- Guideline refers to the national guideline in use at the relevant time

#### Mother not infected at delivery

This is automatically greyed out if Mother: HIV status 'Not HIV infected' is selected above

#### Unknown

Insufficient information available to make one of the above choices

# Feeding in first 6 months

This is self-explanatory. If the child is older, the information is still relevant, as mixed feeding may have contributed to the child's death. If the mother/caregiver cannot remember or does not know, select `Unknown'.

## **Child: HIV status**

## Not HIV infected

 Child tested antibody or antigen negative, with either an HIV rapid, ELISA, or PCR test, and at least 6 weeks after the cessation of breastfeeding.

#### HIV exposed (perinatal or ongoing breast milk)

- Mother tested antibody positive in pregnancy, and/or whilst breastfeeding
- A child <u>under</u> 24 months of age with a positive antibody test, but negative PCR test

## **HIV** infected

- A child over 24 months of age with a positive antibody test (rapid, or ELISA test)
- Antigen positive at any age (HIV PCR positive or detectable HIV viral load)

#### Unknown

Insufficient information available to make one of the above choices

## PCP prophylaxis (cotrimoxazole) - this applies to the child

Record the child's experience of cotrimoxazole prophylaxis, used currently or any time prior to presentation ("**Interrupted**")

Exclude therapeutic cotrimoxazole.

# ART (child)

'ART' refers to exposure to any antiretroviral therapy, apart from PMTCT, used currently or any time prior to presentation ("**Interrupted**")
