






- Insert CD and follow wizard instructions.
- If CD fails to Auto start, click on Start – Run. Click on Browse – find your CD drive and click on setup.exe.











NB Registering PPIP3

- When you open PPIP3 for the first time after installing it, it will ask you for a registration number. You have 30 days to register your PPIP3 by sending an e-mail to: techsupport@ppip.co.za with your name and hospital name. Registration numbers are NOT available from Roz Prinsloo or the MRC Unit.
- You can also request a registration number from the PPIP website www.ppip.co.za.
- A registration number will be sent to you and this must be entered in your PPIP3 together with your hospital name (case sensitive – it must be entered exactly as it was sent to you with capital letters in the same places, spaces in the same places and the hospital name spelt exactly as sent to you).
- Keep your registration number in a safe place.
- ONE registration number per hospital. Your number won't work for another hospital.

Dear Roz,

Thank you for registering your copy of PPIP v3. **Please note:** This licence will activate PPIP v3; if you are still using version 2 and want to request a licence for this older version instead, please indicate this by replying to this email. PPIP v3 can be downloaded from www.ppip.co.za/ppip-downloads.

You must now enter the licence detail on your copy of PPIP. To enter the licensing detail, select 'Help' from the Main menu, and then click on 'Enter PPIP licence detail'. Enter the following information exactly as supplied (case sensitive):

User name: National PPIP Co-ordinator: MRC Unit
Activation code: JBJF-YGJC-KKND-HGY Y

Click on the **Register** button.

If the registration detail was entered correctly, you will receive a message to inform you of this. Please close and restart PPIP to complete the process. If you receive an error message at this point, you probably made a mistake when entering one or both of the fields – please try again!

If you were using PPIP v2, I suggest that you read through the **Migrating from PPIP v2** section of the Help file. This will quickly introduce you to the new and updated program functions, and will explain the process of transporting your existing data to the new version.

Please take note of the following:

- 1) Some of the codes used by PPIP v3 have been changed. When you import v2 data, PPIP will take care of this, but it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that everyone involved in coding causes of death and avoidable factors should start using the new code lists when you start using PPIP v3. This will ensure that the codes you enter in PPIP v3 refer to the correct causes of death and avoidable factors! PPIP can print the new code lists, or you can download and print the lists from the PPIP web site.
- 2) Only one copy of PPIP can be installed and registered on a computer.
- 3) Manually setting the computer data back may interfere with the licence and cause an error message to be displayed.

Welcome to the Data Set Management Wizard

This wizard will assist you to set up Data Sets and one or more data pyramids on your computer. You must have at least one Data Set and one Data Pyramid defined before you can use PPIP.

Definitions:

Data Set A Data Set is a collection of data that you want to group together. Usually this is data from a single health care facility, but it may also be a larger geographic area or logic group of data (e.g. data from a similar level of care). Most Data Sets will contain its own original data (for instance where the Data Set represents a specific health care facility), but you may also create Data Sets which do not contain any data, but are used to group together one or more Data Sets in your Data Pyramid.

Data Pyramid A Data Pyramid is the logic structure you give to your Data Sets to enable you to analyze the data from more than one Data Set. Data Sets containing data from individual health care facilities will make up the lowest level of the pyramid. Two or more of these will then be grouped together as the second level, and two or more level two Data Sets will be grouped together to create a third level... This structure can then continue to a maximum of 25 levels, containing an infinite number of Data Sets. PPIP allows you to set up as many Data Pyramids as you want, allowing you to group together Data Sets in different ways when you analyze your data. When you do any data analysis, you will have to select the Data Pyramid you want to use.

Press the 'Next' button to see an example of a Data Pyramid.


