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WORLD HUNGER IS RISING

It is estimated that up to 811 million people go hungry every day. If it continues at this rate, it'll exceed 840 million by 2030. 48.9 million people are facing emergency levels of hunger.

MALNUTRITION IS RISING

21.3% of children under 5 are stunted.6.9% of children under 5 are affected by wasting.
