I qualified as a Chartered Accountant (SA) in 1973, South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA) and became a member of the Public Accountants' and Auditors' Board in 1974.

I was a partner in PriceWaterhouseCooper (PWC) and its predecessor practices, including Theron du Toit, for the largest part of my career, some 20 years. I became the Executive: Tax Services with Telkom in 2002, initially with the task of guiding tax matter in the listing on the JSE and NYSE in March 2003. I retired from Telkom in April 2012.

I pursued a short academic career, enrolling at the University of Pretoria (UP) for a research MCom in Taxation. The degree MCom (Taxation) was awarded to me in April 2016 for my research piece titled "A Comparative Study of Double Tax Agreements in the Southern African Context."

I was appointed extraordinary lecturer in the Law Faculty at UP from March 2017 to December 2019. I lectured International Tax in the LLM Taxation programme and supervised research of a small number of students.

I was appointed part-time lecturer at Akademia, a higher education institution, in February 2022, responsible for the International Tax module in the post graduate diploma in taxation. The role included lecturing, supervising research and assessment. Currently I am no longer involved with Akademia.

I was elected as a pensioner trustee in the Telkom Retirement Fund (TRF) in April 2024 where I serve on the Audit, Risk and Compliance Committee. The TRF has some 22,000 members and pensioners, with plan assets of about 42,000 Rm.
