Professor Dr Martijn van der Steen is Associate-Dean and Deputy-director of the Netherlands School of Public Administration (NSOB) in The Hague, The Netherlands. He is also a professor of Public Administration at Erasmus University Rotterdam (EUR), in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, and is member of the Adjunct Faculty of the Hertie School of Governance in Berlin, Germany. He is also Extraordinary Professor at the School of Public Leadership at the University of Stellenbosch in South Africa. His research focuses on new modes of governance, networked governance, and public sector strategy. He has published in many academic journals about these topics and also published a variety of professional publications. Moreover, he worked on many commissioned research projects on new modes of governance in policy fields such as energy policy, education policy, health policy, multi-level governance, crime policy, and civic engagement (and the consequences of active citizenship and social enterprises on the role of government). Professor Van der Steen will talk about new modes of governance in general, based on his research in a broad range of policy fields, and use these insights to reflect on the current developments in the field of education policy and education governance
