- Conduct research and compile draft chapters for consideration (no submission to supervisor during June/Nov exam and Dec/ Jan recess period)

STEP 2: Student:

- Obtain SPMA supervisor's approval for submission and 1st formal submission to SPMA Postgraduate Administrator (2nd week of April for May examination and 2nd week of September for Nov examination)
- Submit electronic copy of the mini-dissertation (inclusive of similarity report, language certificate and Ethics Approval letter)

STEP 4: Examiners:

- Review mini-dissertation 1 month (May/Nov 6 weeks allowed)
- Submit examiner's report/examination forms to SPMA Postgraduate Administrator (Postgraduate Committee) by middle of June/December final results to EMS Faculty Administration
