### **Announcement and Call for Papers**

The *Strategic Review for Southern Africa* is an internationally accredited and peer-reviewed periodical of the Department of Political Sciences at the University of Pretoria. The *Strategic Review* is listed as an accredited journal in South Africa and on the IBSS (international) list of accredited journals. All submissions are peer-reviewed by at least two members of the Editorial Committee and/or external reviewers. Articles published in the *Strategic Review* qualify for a subsidy from the South African Department of Higher Education and Training. Since the journal's establishment in 1978 it has witnessed major social and political changes in Southern Africa, the wider continent of Africa and the world.

As of 2018 with volume 41, no. 2 the journal will be guided by a new editorial team. The team will, however, continue the founding mission to engage in strategic and political analysis of socio-political developments that impact Southern Africa. The changes to the journal are intended to facilitate more vigorous and enlightened debate among scholars, policy makers, practitioners, students and activists, in order to contribute to the wider global discourse on democracy, human rights and freedoms, security, governance, the rule of law, development, and social and ecological justice. The journal therefore seeks to establish a multi-disciplinary forum, where plural and open-minded interaction can transcend purely academic debate, so as to reach out to wider audiences and involve as many stakeholders as possible in the policy and civil society communities

An engaged and engaging exchange will be stimulated by means of academic analyses, reports, debates, a review section and other briefings. Academic articles will, as in the past, be held to impeccable quality control and will be peer reviewed to uphold the journal's scholarly credentials.
