To Whom It May Concern

Approval to enrol for Psychology (SLK) modules within the 'Humanities Special for Non-Degree Purposes' (HSNDP) programme will only be granted in the following circumstances:

- 1. Students who have an undergraduate degree but have not completed all the undergraduate psychology (SLK) modules
- **2.** Students who have an undergraduate degree in another area but are interested in pursuing the psychology route through the SLK-modules not yet completed
- 3. Students who have completed psychology modules more than five years ago.
- 4. IMPORTANT EXCLUSION: <u>Students will not be allowed to repeat first or second-year Psychology (SLK) modules unless</u> they failed these modules
- 5. Students who want to improve their third-year psychology marks and obtained at least 65% or more for these modules in their previous academic year

## STEPS TO FOLLOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION & PERMISSION:

- 1. Apply for admission into the HSNDP programme by contacting the Faculty of Humanities, Student Administration, Ms Moasa at <u>frieda.moasa@up.ac.za</u> for assistance.
- 2. Once admission has been approved by Student Admin (Ms Moasa), the necessary correspondence/status update will appear on your Student Portal.
- 3. Should you need/want to register for more than one module level (refer to points 1 and 2 above), you must contact the Undergraduate Programme Manager, **Dr Sonja Mostert** at <u>sonja.mostert@up.ac.za</u> to supply you with a permission letter. Please note this is only applicable if you did not complete first- or second-year modules before. You need to submit your full academic record to her before permission can be supplied. A cumulative average of 65% is needed for the previous academic year to allow for simultaneous registration of different year-level modules.
- 4. Dr Mostert will only permit more than one level of psychology (SLK) modules, should you comply with the academic requirements.
- 5. Dr Mostert will email the permission letter (if relevant) to you and include Student Admin (Ms Moasa); in the email to finalise your admission into the **HSNP programme.** Students can also share the permission letter with their Student Administration.
- 6. Once approved, you will receive the go-ahead from Student Admin, and you will need to register for the approved SLK-modules. All study guides will be uploaded to clickUP once available. You will have access clickUP/Blackboard for the content, physical contact lectures (compulsory), and virtual materials and tutorials.
