**Research Colloquium – ‘A Southern African Dialogue on the Professions and Professional Work’ University of Pretoria, Pretoria, South Africa, 18-19 September 2017**

A successful colloquium focusing on ‘A Southern African Dialogue on the Professions and Professional Work’ was held at the University of Pretoria, on the 18th and 19th September 2017.

The colloquium was jointly organised by Professor Debby Bonnin and Dr. Shaun Ruggunan from the discipline of human resources management at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. It was the first cohesive attempt in South Africa to bring together scholars with an interest in the sociology of professions from a Southern African perspective.

In total there were 22 participants, presenting 19 papers. Papers represented empirical work done in South Africa, Zimbabwe and Togo. Professor Mike Saks (University of Suffolk), presented a keynote address to the larger university community, as well as provided feedback to emerging scholars in a special workshop for graduate students. It is planned that selected papers from the colloquium will be published in a special issue of *Professions and Professionalism*.

The event was sponsored by International Sociology Association’s Research Committee 52 (Sociology of Professional Groups), the Faculty of Humanities, University of Pretoria and the University of KwaZulu-Natal.
