BA Fine Art application and selection procedure for 2024

Minimum requirements for admission

- National Senior Certificate or equivalent qualification
- An Admission Point Score (APS), a minimum of 30
- A minimum of 60% for English language (home or first additional)
- Art as a school subject is NOT a requirement

Application process-3 steps

Please be aware that failure to complete any of the 3 steps outlined hereafter will result in the termination of your application.

Step 1 of 3: Application at UP

Applications for the year 2024 open on 1 April 2023. **Applications are online** only. The closing date for UP applications for BA Fine Art is **29 September 2023**.

Step 2 of 3: Application for Fine Art

Portfolio and Questionnaire submission

You are required to submit a physical A4 size portfolio containing ten (10) artworks and a completed questionnaire to the Visual Arts Building, for attention: Fine Art Programme.

- The **portfolio** should be photographs of your original artwork in a Flip file with a cover page stating your name.
- The portfolio should include two (2) A4 size original drawings from observation. Two (2) photographs of your own choice and six (6) photographs of artworks in your area of practice (painting, sculpture, ceramics, or installations).
- The **questionnaire** requires information about yourself, achievements, personal interests, and motivation for study.

The **deadline** for submission is 29 September 2023.

Step 3 of 3: Online interview

You will be notified in October via email to participate in an **online interview** with Fine Art staff members. Should you not receive a reply via email by 20 October 2023, you can assume that you do not qualify for Step 3, the final process.
