### What can I expect from living in res?

Taking the res option will provide you with:

**An active student life** – You will be expected to join in and become part of a vibrant student life. One of the highlights is Rag, where men's and women's residences team up together and have loads of fun (all in the name of charity). Res is also a place where you will meet people and make friends for life.

**Structure** – Living in res will give a certain structure to your life. In most cases, meals are provided and your res will be maintained. Self-catering residence options are also available.

**Security** – Res offers a secure environment – in fact, living in res can be one of the safest accommodation options available. Tuks maintains strict security in and around its residences to ensure the safety of students and their possessions.

### Services to support you

When you live in res, you have access to a range of professional support services to help you along the way. These include:

**Client Service Centre (CSC)** – The CSC provides integrated and technologically advanced service through customer relationship management. It oversees the quality experience of your entire student lifecycle and provides you with a consolidated entrance to the university.

**TuksRes Student Support** can help you in:

**Department Student Support** – Aims to ensure academic excellence through vocational guidance, social and psychological care. The Department creates an environment that is equitable to all students and fosters an atmosphere that is conducive to effective learning.

Services include: courses on study methods, reading skills, conflict management, dealing with stress, life skill development, time management, career planning, communication skills and free medical consultation and primary health care services.

**TuksSport** – Tuks has one of the most comprehensive sporting facilities in Africa. The LC de Villiers Sport Grounds, covering 76 hectares, are conveniently located to most residences surrounding the Hatfield Campus.

**Culture** – Tuks provides a diversity of cultural activities and offers ample opportunity for you to enjoy and participate in literary, musical and dramatic performances, fine arts exhibitions, festivals, public lectures and much more. In addition, students are also encouraged to engage actively in community projects – many of which are initiated or adopted as res projects.

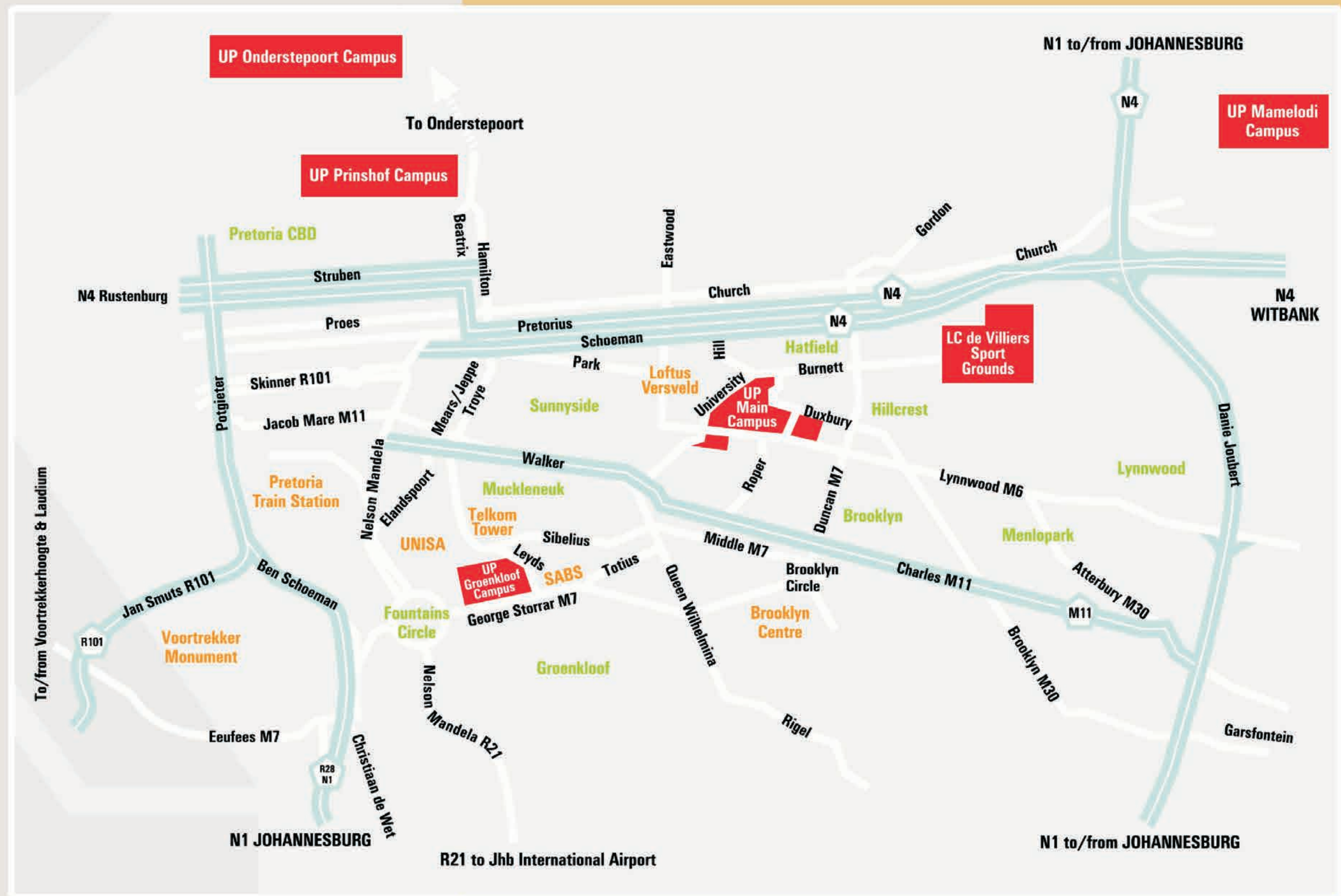
**SSC (Student Sport)** - Sport is an integral part of being a Tukkier! In this regard, the SSC is the service provider responsible for administering Student Sport at Tuks. The house league caters for Soccer, Netball, Rugby, Cricket, Hockey and Basketball. Also on the Student Sport calendar is the popular Big Brag and Intervarsity against other Universities. The SSC is housed in the Roosmaryn Building office 2-25 Main Campus. Tuks of Niks.

**TuksFM (since 1981)** – TuksFM was established in 1981 and has been at the forefront of providing talent to the commercial broadcasting industry for 26 years. The direct target market of TuksFM is a Greater Tshwane youth market, universally cosmopolitan, with an indirect audience of scholars. Tuks FM has a listenership of 50 000 with an audience loyalty factor of 64%, which means 64% of our audience is loyal to TuksFM exclusively. "TuksFM: Your Music, Your Capital"

**Perdeby (since 1938)** – The Perdeby is the official student newspaper of the University of Pretoria and publishes on average 21 editions a year. We are the biggest student newspaper in South Africa. Perdeby is written by students for students.

**RAG (Reach out And Give)** – The mission of Tuks Rag is to develop students by channelling their energy and search for pleasure towards fundraising and community service projects. Tuks Rag was founded over seventy years ago and is presently the biggest organisation of its nature in South Africa and the third biggest in the world. Students take part on a completely voluntary basis and receive no financial compensation for their time and efforts.

Residences are located in close proximity to the Hatfield Campus's lecture halls and laboratories, Client Service Centre; Student Support Services; Student Centre; SRC office; study and computer centres; main, music and law libraries; Musion; Aula; The Lier, Tuks museums, galleries and collections; Tuks FM; recreation venues and LC de Villiers Sports Centre. Residences are in close proximity of churches, shopping malls and public transport routes.

Groenkloof Campus

TuksRes Accommodation

- Residence rooms are equipped with the following: bed, mattress, bookcase, desk and chair, cupboard and a mirror.
- The following equipment is allowed in rooms: small fridge, microwave oven, kettle, radio, computer, iron, pop-up bread toaster, fan and oil heater.
- The following equipment is not permitted in rooms: any apparatus working with gas, two plate stove, frying pan, open element heater, 'popklap' bread toaster, snackwich.
- The windows in men's residences are fitted with blinds.
- Students placed in ladies residences and residences on the Groenkloof and Prinshof Campuses must bring their own curtains. Measurements for windows are available with the relevant Coordinator: Residence Facilities.
