



Prof Maritz appointed to SACQSP Council

Prof Tinus Maritz, head of the Department of Construction Economics and chairperson of the School for the Built Environment, was appointed by the minister of Public Works to the South African Council for the Quantity Surveying Profession (SACQSP) in August 2009 for a second four-year term.

Prof Maritz has been associated with the School for the Built Environment at the University of Pretoria since 1975. He is also a registered professional quantity surveyor, and a director at Schoombie Hartmann Pretoria (Pty) Ltd, a quantity surveying firm with various branches in South Africa. His main research interests are legal aspects of building contracts, dispute resolution, contractual alternatives, and model documentation.

He serves on various professional bodies and committees, such as the

council and board of SACQSP and ASAQS respectively, the technical and review committees of the Joint Building Contracts Committee (JBCC), the Standard System Joint Committee of ASAQS and the MBSA (formerly BIFSA) and the Preliminaries Committee of the JBCC.

He is also the ASAQS representative on the JBCC. He is the author and co-author of a large number of technical handbooks and standard documentation for the quantity surveying profession. 📌
