THE TRASHURE HUNT: WALKING-TIME AND IDENTITIES

Myer Taub's talk will introduce the idea of the trashure hunt as part of an activation of a week-long treasure hunt that begins at the GRIND Studio Space on the evening of the 12th of March 2014 and ends a week later, 19th of March at the same time and location.

The lecture presentation will include several in-studio performances and the first time screening of two video art works: Xuetas: Pork Chop filmed in Barcelona in 2013 and Trashure Hunt filmed in Johannesburg in 2014

> Myer Taub teaches in the Drama Department at the University of Pretoria. Here his field of interest is to engage with the complexities of practise-as-research and performance as research; so as to develop creative and critical facilities through experiential learning; and promote a working process and a mode of performance conducive to the development of artist as scholar, and scholar as performer. He completed his doctorate called "Lessons From An Aftermath": a combined study in drama practice and narrative strategy at the University of Cape Town in 2009.



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
