Sy trek haar neus op vir konvensies - slaap met haar voete op die kussing en haar kop onder die lakens! Sy is vir niks bang nie en draf booswigte gou-gou kaf. Haar troeteldiere is 'n apie en 'n perd, haar beste vriende die buurkinders Tommie and Annika. Sy versin wonderbaarlike stories oor haar avonture vir hulle - waarvan sommige waarlik uitdraai om die waarheid te wees!

Die opvoedkundige waarde van die Pippie Langkous-stories lê in hul vermoë om kinders aan te moedig om die wêreld te bevraagteken en dit nie onnadenkend te betree nie. Pippie leer uit haar foute en aanvaar die gevolge van haar keuses.

Pippy Longstocking has been entertaining children for generations. Since her debut in Sweden in 1945, she remains one of the most popular children's characters in youth fiction the world over.

Our nine year old heroine with her remarkable strength, a suitcase filled with gold coins, fiery plaits, freckled face and odd attire, lives by herself in Villa Villekulla. Her father, the legendary seafaring captain Ephraim Longstocking, roams the globe. Pippy is independent, unconventional and optimistic. She scorns conventions – sleeps with her feet on her pillow and tucks her head under the sheets! She is fearless, and quite easily deals with any rogue. She has a pet monkey, as well as a horse, and her best friends are the neighbours Tommy and Annika. She thinks up amazing adventure stories with which she amuses them – some of which turn out to actually be true!

The educational value of the Pippy Longstocking stories lies in the encouragement of children to question the world and not to embark on anything which had not been thoroughly considered. Pippy makes mistakes (from which she learns), and accepts the consequences of her mistakes, as well as those of her choices.
