The deaths of 34 strikers at the hands of heavily armed South African police, on the 16th of August 2012, rocked viewers across the world.

This book presents eight narratives, told through visual art and in words, of women who are family members of men killed in the Marikana Massacre. These stories came from workshop held in May 2013, while the women sat in silence at the Marikana Commission of Inquiry.

These women's lives linked to the men killed in the Marikana massacre, sharing their needs and struggles, children, decisions, and dreams of the future. Yet these women have been unheard – until now. As a society we need to hear these stories.
