- Supporting documentation that must be provided by the applicant:
 - Application Form with photograph attached
 - Proof of registration or acceptance into university for course applying for
 - Academic history progress report with a 65% pass rate average, if currently a student (or matric results)
 - Proof of tuition costs or estimation of costs from university (not online portals)
 - Proof of learning material costs (text books, library cards etc)
 - Proof of accommodation or estimation costs from Residence, landlord or affidavit from parents
 - · Estimation of travel costs to and from campus
