Requirements:

- Applicant must be under 40 years of age as of 1 Sept 2013
- Must hold a Bachelor or Master's degree as of 1 Sept 2012
- Must maintain a grade point average (GPA) of 80% or higher from previously attended institution
- Following documents must be attached to application:
 - ➤ Certified copies of undergraduate certificates
 - > Certified copies of undergraduate transcripts
 - > Certified copies of postgraduate certificates
 - > Certified copies of postgraduate transcripts
 - ➤ Certified copy of TOEFL or IELTS certificates
 - > Certified copy of passport
 - ➤ Photo (3cmx4cm)

Scholarship will cover:

- Airfare: Round-trip economy class ticket (not domestic travel within home country)
- Monthly Allowance: 900,00 won (KRW) per month
- Research Allowance: 210,00 won (Humanities & Social Sciences), 240,000 won for (Natural & Mechanical Sciences) per semester
- Relocation (Settlement) Allowance: 200,00 won upon arrival
- Language Training Fee: Full coverage
- Tuitions: All fees (paid by NIIED)
- Dissertation Printing costs: 500,00 800,00 won (depending on actual costs)
- Medical Insurance: 20,000 won per month (limited coverage)
