

# CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SOUTH AFRICAN STUDENTS

2013/2014

The Scholarship is available for undergraduate, masters, doctoral or language studies

## Criteria & Eligibility

- South African citizens in good health with a strong academic record.
- Available to study in China from September 2013 (extension will not be allowed)
- Demonstrated an interest in China and commitment to the development of South Africa.
- Applications from all qualified candidates in any field will be accepted, but priority will be given to applications for postgraduate studies, previously disadvantaged applicants and applicants in the following fields:
  - Chinese language studies
  - Natural resource management and geology
  - Public Policy (public sector reform, trade and diplomacy)
  - Health (nursing, medicine and pharmacy)
  - Water and sanitation
  - Food security, agriculture and rural development
  - Engineering and the built environment
  - Finance and economics
  - Veterinary science
  - Bio-resource engineering

## What is covered by the Scholarship

- Registration fee, tuition fee, fee for laboratory experiment, fee for internship, fee for basic learning materials, and shared accommodation in international dormitory on campus.
- Basic living allowance
- Once-off settlement subsidy after registration
- Medical insurance
- Once-off economy train ticket from airport to Institution (for first time arrival in China and final departure)

NOTE the scholarship **DOES NOT** cover flights to China. Students are also expected to supplement their living allowance and have funds available for unforeseen expenses.
