

Humanities multi-disciplinary team research project funding

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Academics in the Faculty of Humanities who have established or wish to establish multi-disciplinary research projects and meet the following criteria are invited to submit applications for a Mellon team research grant for these projects.

Criteria for the selection of research projects for funding:

- The project should have the capacity to meaningfully contribute to the field of humanities in South Africa.
- The project should have the capacity to contribute to an appreciation of the value of humanities within the University and broader society.
- The project should involve at least five postgraduate (master's and doctoral) students at any point in time over the next three-year period.
- The project should have the potential to facilitate participating students' endeavours to complete their master's or doctoral degrees within the prescribed period of time.
- The project should have the potential to increase the research and publications outputs of the Faculty.
- Early-career academics should constitute at least 20% of the project team.
- The project should have the capacity to contribute to endeavours to address the under-representation of academics of colour in the Faculty. Researchers and students of colour should therefore constitute at least 25% of the project team.

Funding

Substantial funding will be provided to qualifying projects for the following project components:

- project administration
- distinguished visiting scholars
- doctoral fellowship
- workshops/symposia/public lectures

The approximate value of this grant is a total of **R500 000.00 per year** for a three-year period. The grant has been made available to the Faculty through funding by the Andrew W Mellon Foundation.
