

Eligibility

In selecting applicants for consideration for funding, the following criteria will apply:-

- Applicants must be South African citizens or permanent residents.
- The student must have been an NRF bursary recipient for the current degree i.e.
- either in receipt of an NRF freestanding or grant-holder linked bursary.
- An applicant may not concurrently hold the extension bursary support with another NRF scholarship or any other scholarship from a South African government source.
- The NRF scholarship should be held as primary in all cases of supplementary funding.
- Scholarship recipients will be allowed to undertake a maximum of 12 hours of employment per week, such as teaching, tutorials, assistance or demonstration duties during tenure of the award provided that they are remunerated for these duties at a rate not exceeding the normal institution tariff for services rendered.

• An applicant may not be in full-time employment for the duration of the funding period.

Value of extension bursary support

Support for completion of studies will be made on a *pro rata* basis. For the 2013 academic year, the value of the bursaries will be as follows:

Masters Bursaries (Rand)	= R70 000.00
Doctoral Bursaries (Rand)	= R100 000.00
NRF Freestanding Master Bursaries (Rand)	= R40 000.00
NRF Freestanding Doctoral Bursaries (Rand)	= R60 000.00
Grant-holder linked Master Bursaries (Rand)	= R40 000.00
Grant-holder linked Doctoral Bursaries (Rand)	= R60 000.00

How to apply for funding

Applications for funding in 2013 must be submitted through an online application process to the NRF by accessing the link: <u>http://phoenweb.nrf.ac.za/FPF2</u>

On accessing the link, please follow the instructions as follows:

- Remember to complete all sections of the application.
- Important: Remember to invite your supervisor/ host to comment on progress
- of study by selecting the invite button on the application.
- Remember to submit your application on completion.
- Complete applications will be sent to the host university for verification before being forwarded to the NRF for further processing.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria will not be considered (please refer to call document for details on
- eligibility criteria for the extension of NRF masters and doctoral programme).
