Bradlow Foundation Scholarship

PhD Studies

Please note that (with the occasional exception for truly outstanding applicants) a scholar will only be selected every second year.

Those **eligible for consideration** for funding from the Bradlow Foundation are **South African nationals** who:

- (a) have applied to the University of Cambridge to read for a PhD degree from the academic year 2014/15;
- (b) have listed St. John's College as their first choice college on the Graduate Application Form provided by the University's Graduate Admissions Office (formerly known as the Board of Graduate Studies);
- (c) have received a conditional offer of a graduate place from St John's College by 31 May 2014;
- (d) are still under 30 years of age on that date.

What is covered (R330 000 per annum)

- 1. Air travel to and from London at inception and completion of studies
- 2. University Fees
- 3. Accommodation
- 4. Some pocket money

Is renewal for three years subject to satisfactory progress being made by the student.

Please note that the Board of Graduate Studies, St John's College and the Bradlow Foundation *do not* provide a separate form of application for the Competition.

Applicants should not apply direct to the Foundation. St John's College will (after 31 May 2014) forward the papers of suitable applicants to the Foundation. The Bradlow Foundation will then contact applicants direct if they wish to consider them in the Scholarship Competition.
