#### **CONDITIONS OF THE NRF AWARD**

- 1. Ensure you make yourself familiar with the Eligibility & conditions of this scholarship.
- 2. These scholarships do not bind successful candidates to enter the NRF's service after completion of their studies.
- 3. Successful applicants are, however, expected to complete the degree for which the scholarship was awarded in the minimum period.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE - REPAYMENT CLAUSE:

- (i) If a student who receives an NRF award discontinues his/her studies in the same year as having received the NRF award, the award is repayable by the recipient to the NRF.
- (ii) If a student fails to achieve the degree or fails to achieve the degree in the minimum period, the award is repayable to the NRF. In such cases, the full value of the award may be reversed from the student's fee account and repaid by the University to NRF. The student will then be liable to UP for the resultant outstanding balance on her/his account.
- 4. The requirements given below must be met by all applicants:
  - The NRF Scholarship may not be held concurrently with bursaries, grants or emoluments which bind the recipient to enter the service of the contract holder on completion of their studies.
  - The NRF Scholarship may not be held together, or concurrently with any other NRF award.
  - The NRF Scholarship may not be held together or concurrently with any other bursary/scholarship from any other Government source (e.g. CSIR, SA Actuaries Dev Programme).





It must be emphasized that only a limited number of scholarships are available. The NRF scholarship will be awarded on a competitive basis and in strict accordance with the NRF's prescribed equity and discipline quotas. Submission of an application and meeting the criteria does not guarantee that an award will be made.
