- Academic mobility including (staff and student exchange programmes)
- International work integrated learning placements and its impact on the quality of graduates

TYPES OF PRESENTATIONS

- Peer reviewed academic papers will form part of the conference proceedings
- Practice driven papers/non refereed papers/sharing of projects and good practice

<u>Note:</u> in both categories above you have the option of an oral presentation or poster presentation

STUDENT CONFERENCE (Day 1)

Proposals for the Student Conference should address any of the streams. They can be in the form of workshops, poster sessions and papers with a specific student interest and focus. The Student Conference focus will be engaging student leaders and students in general on the imperatives of continental and regional engagement.

MAINSTREAM CONFERENCE (Days 2, 3 and 4)

Academic peer reviewed papers, non reviewed papers, workshops, round tables, poster presentations, project presentations

All proposals/abstracts should be 250 words or less and should be submitted online at ieasaconference@dut.ac.za

TIME LINES

- All proposals to be received on or before 15 June 2011
- Decision on the proposal and request for full papers to be made by 30 June 2011
- Full papers to be submitted by 15 July 2011

Guidelines for submission of full papers:

- 1. Length: Minimum 2500 words and Maximum 5000 words (presentation 20 minutes)
- 2. Spacing: 1.5
- 3. Font: Times New Roman
- 4. Font Size: 12
- 5. Format: Microsoft Word

Please also provide the following;

- 1. Table of headings
- 2. Glossary of terms
- 3. Bibliography
- 4. Where third party material has been used, signed copyright permission

- 5. Author biographies
- 6. Author photographs (colour passport size)
- 7. Co-contributor Agreement
