

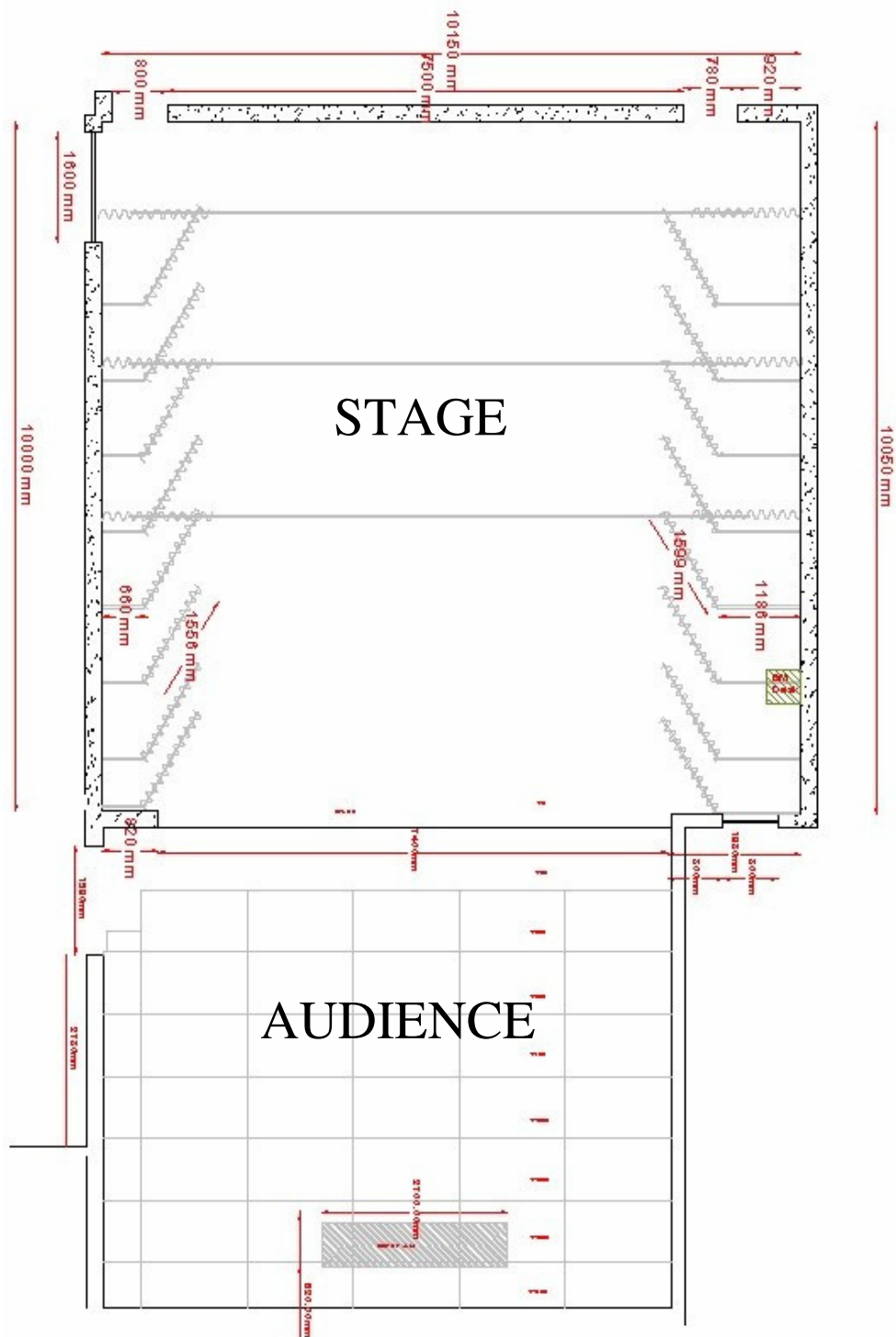
# THE KRËKVAR'S STUDENT ARTS FESTIVAL 2010 VENUE GUIDE

## Lier Theatre

**Description:** A medium sized stage ideal for intimate productions.

**Seating Capacity:** 80

**Dimensions:** 7.5m X 10.05m

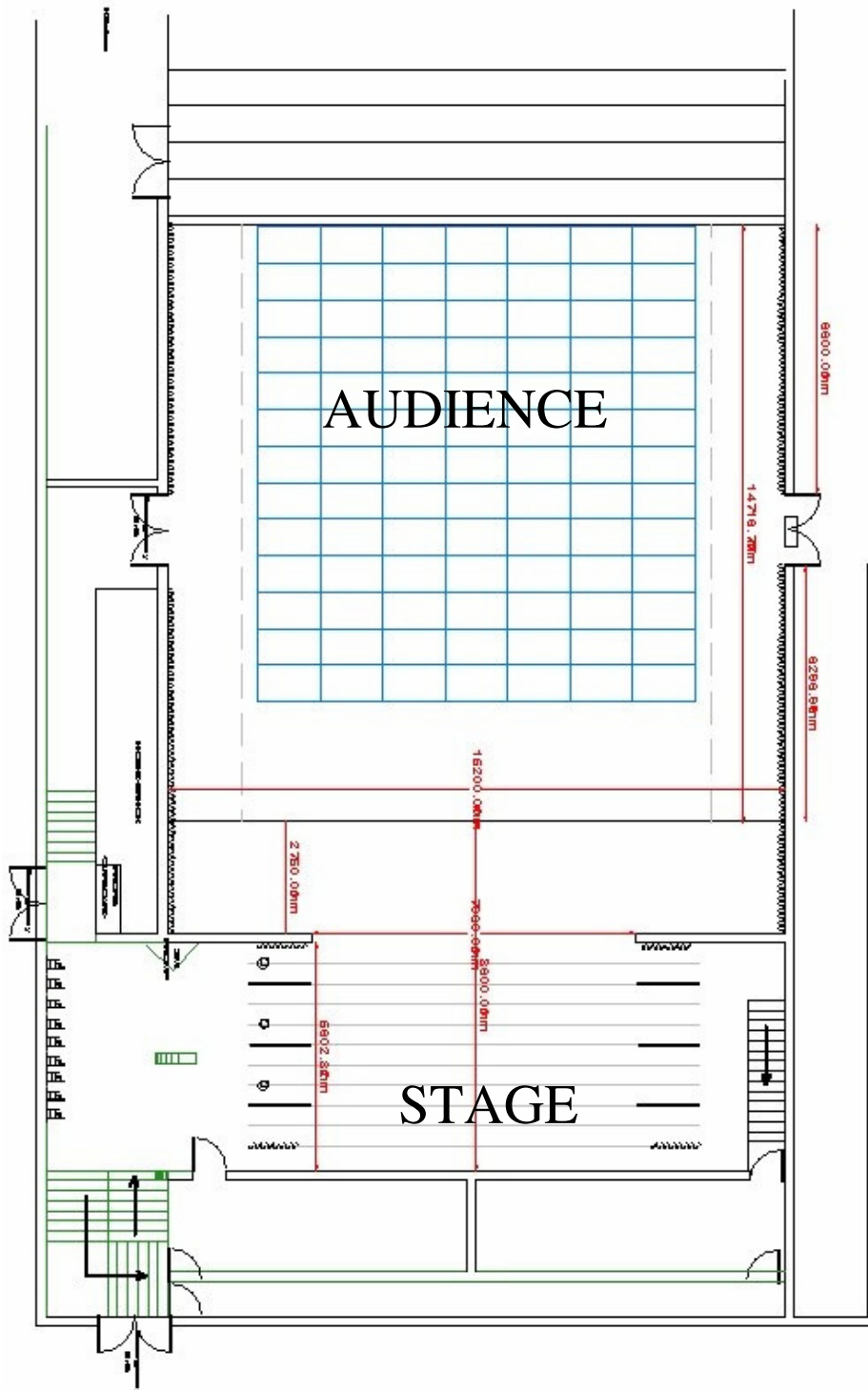


# Masker Theatre

**Description:** The largest venue at the festival. Usually used for bigger productions with larger casts. Ideal venue for musicals, choreographed movement and dance productions.

**Seating Capacity:** 117

**Dimensions:** Approx 9m X 7m (plus an extra 2.75m X 16m)



## Chapel Theatre

**Description:** A small, intimate theatre ideal for one-man shows and music productions (Small music groups, bands etc.)

**Seating Capacity:** 40

**Dimensions:** Approx 4m X 3m

## Film Studio

**Description:** A small studio used to screen all movies at the festival.

**Seating Capacity:** 21

**Dimensions:** n/a

## The Bok

**Description:** This venue is the festival's "kuier plek", the place to be between shows where you can enjoy something to eat and your favourite beer or wine. Each night after the final show is done, The Bok becomes a place to socialise and enjoy the festival's vibe. Themed nights, including open mic, stand-up comedy, music and games will provide entertainment throughout the week.
